NEW ENTRANT IN PROVISION OF SHARE REGISTRY

MainstreamBPO is now supporting the share registry requirements of exchange traded funds (ETF's). Our first ETF client is Australian Index Investments. They will be offering six ETF's listed on the ASX. MainstreamBPO has adopted its unlisted registry system (Hi-Trust) to meet the listed registry processing requirements. COO of MainstreamBPO Martin Smith said "we have always had aspirations to offer listed registry. A number of our clients have listed investment companies and are listed entities in their own right. We have been encouraged to move into listed share registry by a market that is dominated by a couple of providers, and companies are looking for alternative registry solutions."

MainstreamBPO is different from other registry companies as we also offer NAV pricing, fund accounting and ASX reporting. MainstreamBPO also provides reporting to the market maker and investment manager to rebalance the portfolios.

We see this as an exciting opportunity to build market share in the listed registry space. Smith says "we are good at unlisted registry where the investors are also the customers and standards of reporting are high so we should be able to offer good value and personalised services in listed registry."
